



ENTRY INFORMATION

HOW TO ENTER

Teams are required to complete a Registration Form found on the website or by contacting the administration office. All details must be fully completed and submitted with payment by the due date noted on the form.

Payment can be made via cheque to:

Alternatively, payment can be made in person to the stadium's administration:

During business hours 9.00am – 5.00pm Monday – Friday.

or to the Cashiers booth 6.30pm – 9.30pm Monday – Friday and 9.00am – 5.00pm Saturday

Please note, no Eftpos or credit facilities available, cash or cheque only.

LATE REGISTRATIONS

Teams that do not submit their registration forms by the due date are not guaranteed their nominated competition. **Late registrations will only be accepted if space permits.**

AGE

Players must be 16 years of age at commencement of the season. If players under the age of 16 register to play, they must fill out an age indemnity form with their parents permission to acknowledge the risks. Age indemnity forms can be obtained from the website www.waverleybasketball.com

WITHDRAWAL

Teams withdrawing after the fixtures have been prepared will forfeit their entry fee and bond.

WALKOVERS

By contacting the administration office 48 hours prior to your game and notify us you are unable to play, the Notified Walkover Fines are \$50.00. If you fail to notify us, the Un-notified Walkover Fines = \$80.00

Walkover Fines must be paid the following week at your next game.

Failure to do so will forfeit any ladder points for games played while the fine is outstanding.

WEEKLY COSTS

Game fees for each match is \$45.00 per team. Door entry per person is \$3.00

BONDS

\$150 Bond is to be paid by all NEW teams. The bond is refundable upon departure from competition providing your team has no unpaid accounts. Please apply in writing to WBA via post or email if you wish to obtain your bond and ensure you include full name and address and team details.

FIRST AID

First Aid is the responsibility of each team. Ice can be obtained from the ice chest in the canteen foyer and band-aids from the canteen or referee's room.

QUALIFICATIONS

It is the team's responsibility to check qualification lists. These are displayed on the website throughout the season and automatically updated after each game.
